

BARAZCHUK BROKE AWAY LAST MAY RECENTLY CAPTURED

**Was Arrested in Winnipeg and
Charged with Stealing Bicycles
May be Punished**

Martin Barazchuk, the prisoner captured a few days ago in Winnipeg, who escaped on May 29th from the Arena where he had been interned, is expected in the city in a few days, and will probably be punished for his escape.

With another man named Peter Dulco, on the night of May 29th, he tore the wire screen from one of the windows at the southwest end of the Arena, and, waiting until the sentry was at the far end of the building they jumped to the street, a distance of about fourteen feet.

Peter Dulco fractured his ankle in the fall and was arrested in the early morning by the police as he crouched under the verandah of a vacant house. He was handed over to the military authorities and sentenced to serve fourteen days in jail.

Barazchuk is twenty-one years of age, and was interned among the first of the prisoners brought to the city.

Barazchuk was arrested by the provincial police at Winnipeg several days ago on a charge of stealing bicycles from residents at Brooklands. He appeared in the police court in Winnipeg, but was handed over to the military authorities.
