

# FAREWELL FOR 136 ITALIANS WHO LEAVE

## SAULT THURSDAY

Local Italians Will Give Them  
a Send-off on Tuesday  
Evening —

The Italian Societies of the city will hold a farewell reception on August 31 in their hall Murray and Allen streets for the Italian reservists who are leaving the city on Thursday for New York whence they will sail on the Steamer Napoli of the Navigazione Generale Italiana Line for Naples. This is the second party of reservists to leave the city. Last fall, before the outbreak of the war, a party of 350 left to fight for their native land. The party leaving on September 2 numbers 136, of whom 104 are from the city, the remainder being from Nairn Centre, Chapleau, Worthington and Es-panola. The party will be in charge of Mr. William Grassi, the Italian Consul, of this city. Mr. Grassi informs the Star that a special steamer is always chartered to carry the reservists, and as soon as another steamer could be chartered another large party would be prepared to leave the city. Nearly fifty percents of the party leaving on Thursday are married men, with wives residing in Italy. The Italian Government pays the transportation of the reservists, while the C. P. R. Company pays Mr. Grassi's. The reservists appear to be all big, husky men, and will undoubtedly give a good account of themselves on the battle field. The following is a list of the reservists:
