

# Charles Respa is Called Dynamiter

## Detroit German Wanted for Border Outrages Captured on Sunday

Detroit, Mich., Aug. 30.—While at a picnic on Canadian soil last night, Charles Respa, for whom the Dominion authorities have been searching in connection with the dynamite explosions at Walkerville, Ont., two months ago, was taken in custody on Bois Blanc Island. Respa's home is in Detroit. It is charged that he was one of three or more persons of German descent living in Detroit, who had conspired to destroy the Peabody Overall Plant at Walkerville, the Windsor Armory and other buildings used for military purposes.

Respa was taken to the Walkerville jail and a guard of five policemen placed about his cell. It was announced that he will be arraigned this morning on a charge of attempting to destroy private and public property.

William Lefler, who is serving a term of ten years in the pen at Kingston, Ont., is alleged to have implicated Respa and Albert Kaltschmidt, another Detrouiter, in a confession. Kaltschmidt is living in Detroit. He cannot be extradited.

Toronto morning papers to-day carried an account presumably of this arrest, from Windsor, but giving the man's name as Carl Schmidt. It was said a letter to a German in New York signed "Carl" was recovered from the river when he threw it overboard.
