PROTEST FROM POLES

Resent Being Classed as

Enemy Aliens

Winnipeg, Man., August 30.—At a

meeting of Poles held here, resolu-

tions were passed declaring that the Poles in Canada were the sincere friends of the Allies and appealing for the protection of the Dominion Government from treatment as alien enemies. In the course of the meeting, it was stated that Polish people living in Canada were frequently exposed to unnecessary hardships, partly through their ignorance of the English language and partly because the military registration authorities were not always able to distinguish between a Pole from Austria and Germany and a German or Austrian from those countries.
