"Constantin Dumba, the Austro-Hungarian ambassador at Washington, has admitted that he proposed to his government plans to instigate strikes in American manufacturing plants engaged in the production of munitions of war.
"The information reached this Government through a copy of a let-

ter of the ambassador to his government. The bearer was an American citizen named Archihald, who was travelling under an American passaport. The ambassador has admitted that he employed Archhald to bear official despatches from him to his government.

Conspiracy Against Trade.

"By reason of the admitted purpose and intent of Mr. Dumba to conspire to cripple legitimate industries of the people of the United States and to interrupt their legitimate trade, and by reason of the flagrant ylolation of diplomatic propriety in employing an American Scilizen protected by an American passport as a secret be zer of official despatches through the line of the enemy of Austro-Hungary, the President directs me to inform your excellency that Mr. Dumba is no longer acceptable to the government of the United States as the ambassador of His Imperial Majesty at Washington.
