

## MORTENSON CONFESSED TO TAKING AUSTRIANS ACROSS THE RIVER

Inspector Ross, of the local immigration department, left yesterday for Marquette, where he is to be a witness in the Mortensen case which comes up at this term of the United States Federal Court of this district. Neils Mortensen is charged with smuggling foreigners into this country. He has pleaded guilty to the charge, and has confessed to bringing thirteen Austrians across from Can-

ada. Since he has pleaded guilty the testimony of the four Austrians who were told as witnesses will not be needed. Mortensen is a farmer who owns a farm on the Canadian side near Point Aux Pins.
