have some difficulty stopping them."
"If war is declared what action will the police take?" asked The Star. "Bulgarians here will be treated the

same as Germans or Austrians," he replied. "They will be located and asked to declare their intentions. If they are pro-German then they will be interned," "How do you intend

locating them?" "We can find a great number through the contractors and by various other methods which it

would not be advisable to make pub-
