Bulgarians

Now in Canada



Ottawa, Oct. 8 Internment of alien enemies in Canada, who now exceeds 6,000, will be materially augmented, if, from present indications, Bulgaria goes into war. While the last census give the Bulgarian population as only 1,600, immigration figures place the number at about 20,000.

Since the Bulgarian situation developed, there has been a gradual departure of these people from Canada to the United States, but no restraining action has been taken owing to the absence of any declaration of war and the uncertainty that has prevailed as to which side the Balkan States would jump.

Once war breaks out Bulgarians will be treated like other aliens. Those whose attitude and actions are peaceful will be let alone, but required to register, and where their actions are of a suspicious character they will be interned.
