Consider Helping Crippled Aliens

When Mayor Waugh returns from Ottawa he will be asked by the board of control to take up with the immigration authorities the question of relief for crippled aliens and other aliens not fit for service, and therefore not interned. The Dominion government accepts responsibility only for the relief of aliens capable of military service, and City Relief Officer Frank Kerr points out that the city will be in for a big expense if the immigration authorities do provide for alien relief in the same manner as they have done in the past.
