BULGARIANS HAVE NOT YET REGISTERED Either There are None in the City

or They Pay No Attention to The Regulations MAY NOT KNOW OF THEM

Instructions have been issued that

Bulgarians be now registered as alien enemies, but up to this morning the Brandon registrar, Mr. McChesney,

had not received entries of natives of

the country that took the most recent plunge into war. It is not thought

that there are very many in the city, but an effort will be made to locate them. At the present time Mr. McChesney

has on his books a total of 1,380 aliens who register periodically. There are

880 permanently living in the city, while some 50 are transients. Of the 500 transients, 240 reported

here last month, the others having gone away. When an alien enemy wishes to move to another location he obtains a card and is given permission to go to that place. On arrival he

must present himself and his card to the authorities. The men register once a month, except in a few cases where it is specially desired to keep in touch with

them. Then they may be required to register twice monthly. Failure to keep their parole means internment
