

Bulgarians Angry With Their King

Over Hundred Registered in One Day—Expect Less Trouble With Them than Others

Toronto, Oct. 25.—The work of registering the Bulgarians is proceeding apace at the office of the Registrar of Alien Enemies. Over one hundred were registered in one day. When they closed their books for the night the hall outside the office was crowded with over fifty Bulgarians who still had to be attended to. They were sent away and asked to come again. The work of registering the Bulgarians takes up some time. Apart from the fact that there is no Bulgarian interpreter at the office, yet all the officers in charge have great difficulty in securing information from the foreigners, it must be remembered that the particulars and description of each man has to be written down five times.

Detective Murray states that all the Bulgarians he has interviewed so far are wroth with King Ferdinand for throwing in his lot with the Huns. The police are of the opinion that they will have less trouble with the Bulgarians than with any of the other alien enemies.
