An Alien Enemy Cannot Press Claim Austrian Sought Damages From C.T.R. But Court Re-

fuses Case

Theodore Slogchuk is an Austrian, and an allen enemy, and for

that reason his action against the Grand Trunk Railway Company for damages arising out of an accident, cannot proceed. A motion on the part of the company was made before Mr. Justice Middleton yeareday

and was favorably considered. Slozchuk came to Canada on July 1, 1914, and obtained employment with the G. T. R. at Port Union. He was cutting rails when a rail fell, inflicting injuries to his leg. Unstated damages were claimed against the company because of allexed ner-
