Foil Plot of Aliens to Escape

Officers at Brandon Camp Nip
In Bud Plan of Conspirators
Revealed In Letters

BRANDON, Man., Nov. 27 —A series of attempts to escape from the internment camp here have been brought to light by the seizure of some letters addressed to four of the prisoners and by other letters written by the prisoners. The arrest of an Austrian at Sarnia has resulted and of another in the west is expected.

Nick Popiszoguk, Sarnia, wrote to men in the camp here that he would arrange for their being supplied with \$90 each if they could escape and that if they came to him he would get them over the border. The letters were intercepted by the censor at the camp. Letters written by prisoners were dropped on route marches in the hope that the finders would mail them.

Some turned over to officers gave hints leading to discovery.
