

ARRESTS EXPECTED AT NIAGARA FALLS

George Fuchs, German Conspirator, Lived There; Was Home Recently

Niagara Falls, N.Y., Dec. 18.—George Fuchs, mentioned as the informer against Koenig, in the arrests made in New York in connection with the plots against the Welland Canal, was a former resident of this place where his father was for many years proprietor of the Nassau Hotel.

Fuch's mother was seen to-day at her residence on Buffalo avenue where she has resided since the death of her husband some few years ago. She says her son left some three years ago for New York. He was back for a short visit last September and then returned to New York where he entered the employment of Koenig in the Hamburg-American Line.

The Special Secret Service Agent Strickland, whose headquarters are at Buffalo, is here to-day, and though he does not give out any information, it is expected that several additional arrests will be made in connection with the plot.
