

GUARD TEACHES HOCKEY TO GERMAN PRISONERS INTERNEED AT KINGSTON.

KINGSTON, Jan. 4 — The German prisoners interned at Fort Henry have decided to have a hockey team this winter. Most of them are beginners at the game. There is plenty of space within the fort walls for a good-sized sheet of ice, and the Huns expect instruction from some of the 14th Regiment men who are on guard duty.

A supply of paraphernalia has been sent to the fort. Capt. James H. Sutherland, O.H.A. president, says that he is not surprised that the Germans want to learn hockey. Kingston, he remarks, was the birthplace of modern hockey twenty-seven years ago, and he is hopeful that the game will be carried to Germany.
