

MORTENSEN FINED \$100 AND GOT ONE MONTH IN THE JAIL

For Assisting Alien Enemies
Out of the Country Last
August

Nils Peter Mortensen appeared again before Magistrate Mackay yesterday, and pleaded guilty to a charge of assisting alien enemies out of the country last August. He was fined \$100 and costs, and sentenced to one month in jail, to date from December 18 last.

Mortensen carried four Austrian across the river in a small boat from Point Aux Pins to the Michigan side but was caught red-handed by the American immigration officers.

In imposing sentence yesterday the magistrate took into account the fact that Mortensen had already spent four months and a half in prison on the American side. He was released over there on December 18 and was deported, but was re-arrested immediately he stepped on Canadian soil.
