

MAN HELD FOR CANAL

PLOT GONE, IS RUMOR

New York, Jan. 13. — The reported disappearance of Paul Koenig, head of the Hamburg-American Detective Bureau, was not taken seriously today by Federal officials here. Koenig is under \$50,000 bonds in connection with conspiring to blow up the Welland Canal. He is being sought by the State authorities, who have a warrant for his arrest in connection with the theft of papers from the National City Bank. Secret Service agents said Koenig was ill and that they anticipated no difficulty in finding him when he is needed.
