

PRISONERS WILL BE KEPT ACTIVE AT JASPER CAMP

Alien Enemies in New Home Within Two Weeks—Staff Going West

The close of next week will see the internment camp for alien enemies at Jasper fully established and within two weeks the camp will have settled down to work. While definite approval of the list of officers and men who will be under Major Hopkins, camp commandant, has not been received from headquarters it is expected at any moment, and this week some of the officers and men will proceed to Jasper to get the camp in readiness for the opening. Just when the 300 prisoners, who will be interned there, will pass through Edmonton on their way west from Brandon is not known.

It is expected that the number of prisoners will be increased during the spring and summer. The men will be used to clear brush, cut trails and do other development work in the National park. The program which has been mapped out for them is the most extensive yet undertaken at Jasper, and its fulfilment will render the park much more attractive.
