Wash that Led to Trouble.-A stop to wash their feet in a brook at Hallock, Minn., resulted in the arrest of two Austrians who had just finished a weary like across the international boundary last August. They were grabbed by immigration officials while cooling their pedal extremities in a stream, and were put in jall where they languished for five months. A few days ago they were deported to Canada on the grounds that they had falled to secure permission to enter the United States. The military authorities took them In charge, and yesterday one of them, Felix Jendorovicz, was committed for trial by Magistrate Bonnycastle on a charge of high treason. He was accused of having induced, aided and abetted the other, Florian Shelopat, a registered allen, to leave the Dominion.
