

Wash that Led to Trouble.—A stop to wash their feet in a brook at Hallowell, Minn., resulted in the arrest of two Austrians who had just finished a weary hike across the international boundary last August. They were grabbed by immigration officials while cooling their pedal extremities in a stream, and were put in jail where they languished for five months. A few days ago they were deported to Canada on the grounds that they had failed to secure permission to enter the United States. The military authorities took them in charge, and yesterday one of them, Felix Jendorovicz, was committed for trial by Magistrate Bonnycastle on a charge of high treason.
