

INVESTIGATION DEVELOPS NO CLUE OF ORIGIN OF FIRE

Several reports have been circulated in the last day or two in regard to alleged pro-German trouble at the "works," and an investigation has been conducted by the military authorities which has apparently exploded these stories though the authorities refuse to discuss the matter.

Asked in regard to alleged arrests at the paper mill, officials of the Lake Superior Paper Company said they had not heard of them.

The Star is informed, however, that while there were certain suspicious circumstances in connection with the fire at the Steel Plant yards near the toluol plant on Sunday evening, there is nothing definite on which to base charges. In future, however, every precaution will be taken to guard against a possible recurrence of the fire.
