

GERMAN IN BUFFALO JAIL.

Authorities Take John Bushel In Hand Across Border. Special to The Star.

Buffalo, Feb. 11.—John Bushel, a German, who says he joined the Canadian Secret Service at the outbreak of the European war because he feared he would be interned at Toronto if he did not consent to spy on the movements of Germans there, is in jail here to-day awaiting a decision by immigration officials that will probably result in his deportation to Canada.

Bushel claims he was sent here to investigate reports that German-Americans were drilling, preparatory to making an invasion of Canada. He frequented cafés and restaurants here, where, it was alleged, information was to be obtained. He made some reports and then decided to quit the work and stay out of Canada. Shortly afterwards a complaint was sent to Washington that Bushel was in this country illegally and his arrest followed.

Bushel is very eager to get bail, but none of his German-American friends here have come forward with the necessary \$500 bond.
