FIRST BERLIN INTERNMENT.

Young Man Who Registered, But Failed to Report,

Berlin, Ont., Feb. 20.—The first internment here of an alien of enemy nationality was made yesterday, when Paul Zibell, a young man who failed to report to Chief O'Neill regularly, was sent to Toronto under military guard. He was registered some time ago, but neglected to report. It is expected that other internments will be made within the next few days.
