STEFANIK CHARGED

Said to Have Abetted Alien in Committing Perjury.

Charged with abetting an allen enemy to commit perjury, Theodore Stefanik, former heeler for the Roblin government, ex-alderman and excity detective, appeared in police

court yesterday and was remanded until today so that he might consult his lawyer. This charge is an unexpected aftermath of naturalization scandals in 1914.

Some time ago Wasyl Zuwaski, Austrian, was arrested by the milltary authorities on a charge of being an unregistered allen enemy. He claimed he was naturalized. Investigations showed that he entered Canada on December 2, 1913, and on

June 6, 1914, swore that he had lived in Canada three years when he applied for naturalization papers. When questioned on this discrepancy by the military authorities a few days ago he said that Mr. Stefanik secured his papers for him upon receipt ot \$5 in cash and a bottle of brandy. The police arrested Stefanik Sat-

urday on the strength of this information. He was allowed out on ball later. The alien, Zuwaski, is in the Brandon internment camp, but will be brought to Winnipeg to give,

evidence.
