"Roblin, R. P., et al, conspiracy to defraud," is the case around which most public interest will centre.

Brodour, Joseph, forgery and uttering.

Cromarty, Samuel, theft.

Doerkson, Hendrick, entering a dwelling house at night; housebreaking with intent.

Fox, Mike, murder.

Gilewicz, John, forgery and uttering.

Glowicz, John, theft.

Gimpool, Jack, perjury.

Jendorovica, Felix, assisting alien enemy to leave Canada.

Jereinchuk, John, shopbreaking, receiving, retaining.

Kaschuba Julius, and Bergoine, Daniel, theft, receiving stolen property, retaining stolen property.

Lawrence, George (alias Joseph Pratt), housebreaking and theft.

Owezar, Fred, perjury.

Poleschuk, John, carnal knowledge of a girl under 14; indecent assault on a female (two indictments).

Rimer, W. P., negligently causing bodily injury.

Roblin, R. P., et al, conspiracy to defraud.

Semonouk, Bill, murder.

Simmons, Harry, and Robert, Jack, robbery and theft from the person.

Simpson, Wm., and Simpson, John, assault occasioning bodily harm.

Slater, Geo., and Pruden, James, theft.

Slutsky, Oscar, procuring.

Spain, John J., causing bodily injury.

Sydorko, Demeter, seduction under promise of marriage.

White, Alonzo P., manslaughter, injuring person by furious driving.
