

DISCHARGE ALL GERMANS.

Oshawa Board of Trade's Request to Dominion Government.

Oshawa, Feb. 28.—At the annual meeting of the Oshawa Board of Trade at which J. P. Hennessey was elected president, M. C. Rose, vice-president, and F. E. Hare, secretary, the following interesting resolutions were unanimously passed, calling on the Dominion Government to ask all officials of German or Austrian descent to resign, at least until the war is terminated, as the Canadian generosity of spirit would never be exercised in Germany toward British subjects.
