

# GOOD ROADS CONGRESS NEXT YEAR IN WINNIPEG

ADVISORY BOARD, COMPOSED OF  
PAST PRESIDENTS OF ASSOCI-  
ATION, TO BE CREATED.

Montreal, March 10.—Winnipeg was selected as the place of meeting for the 1917 convention of the Canadian and International Good Roads Congress at the annual meeting here this afternoon of the Dominion Good Roads Association in Sohmer Park.
