KOHLER STREET NOT

Referring to a letter that appeared in the Star on Monday suggesting that the name of Kohler street be changed because of its German sound, Rev. Father Richard, the popular Roman

Catholic Missionary, has called our attention to the fact that this street was named after Rev. Father Kohler, an Alsatian priest, who left his na-

tive Alsace for Canada many years before the Franco-Prussian war of 1879, when Alsace was still a French providce. 'Father Kohler, who work-

ed for several years in this section,

was drowned in Lake Huron/about 35

years ago. Father Richard left this morning on one of his regular trips to Michipi-
