DR. YOUNG RESIGNS.

London, Ont., March 16.—The resignation of Venerable Archdeacon Dr. W. A. Young, as Secretary-Treasurer of the Anglican Diocese of Huron, was presented at a meeting of the Synod Executive to-day.

Dr. Young is retiring because of advancing years and failing health. The resignation was accepted with regret.
