

Father and Son Up in Court on Sedition Charge

Theodore Clausen Accused of Second Offense At Red Deer

RED DEER, Alberta, April 5.—Theodore Clusen and his son, Charles Clusen, German-American farmers residing near here, were arrested on a charge of sedition and came up before Inspector Lindsay yesterday and were remanded till Tuesday, April 11. The father was allowed bail, but the son was taken to Calgary to await the preliminary hearing. This is the second time Theodore Clusen has appeared on a charge of sedition, he having appeared before Mrs. Justice Simmons at the last criminal court here and was found guilty and received a \$50 fine.
