CHECKS MADE OUT BY  
CAPTAIN VON PAPEN, RECALLED GERMAN  
MILITARY ATTACHE, TO THE ORDER OF  
CAPTAIN HANS TAUSCHER

Capt. Hans Tauscher, an officer of the German navy and husband of Mme. Johanna Gadski, opera singer, is under arrest in New York on a United States federal warrant charging him with conspiracy to blow up the Welland canal in Canada. Capt. Tauscher is the American representative of the Krupp gun works of Essen, Germany. The cheques reproduced herewith show that Capt. Tauscher was on intimate terms with Capt. von Papen, and did work for him. Von Papen has been named frequently as "the man behind" the conspiracy to wreck the Welland canal and destroy other Canadian property.
