

# ALIEN ENEMIES GOT A HEATED RECEPTION

Other Tannery Employees in  
Bracebridge Went on Strike,  
House Was Burned Down.

Bracebridge, Ont., April 15.—Ten Austrians from the internment camp in New Ontario who arrived here early yesterday to work in the local tannery, met with such a hostile reception that they left town again on the first outgoing train. The building in which they were to have been lodged, was burned to the ground about the time of their arrival and the tannery employees went on strike at 7 o'clock and were joined by the employees of another tannery. The situation looked so serious it was considered wiser to send the aliens away again.
