SOLDIERS CALLED OUT WHEN BULGARS STRIKE

Trouble on Welland Canal—Aliens
Demand Higher Wages and Attack Russians and Italians.

By Canadian Press. St. Catharines, Ont., April 17.-A detachment of the 98th Battalion has just left for Port Weller, where a body of Bulgarian laborers on the ship canal demanding 25 cents per hour instead of 20 this morning, quit work and then chased Russians, Italians and men of other nationalities off the work by pelting them with stones. The police and militia were hurriedly telephoned for. Serious trouble is not anticipated as the strikers are apparently unarmed. There are several hundred men concerned.
