Teaching Germans English, H. M. Peach, Y.M.C.A., representative at Fort Henry, has purchased a number of public school grammars

for use in the instruction of the prisoners-of-war at the internment camp. Mr. Peach intends to carry on classes for every prisoner interested so that

at the end of the war when they are geleased they will be able to speak English fluently and have a working knowledge of the writing and reading in the language.
