

GERMAN PRISONERS

AT CALGARY ESCAPE

Lethbridge, Alta., April 29.—Six German prisoners in detention camp here have escaped by digging a tunnel over a hundred feet long, leading under the fence into the adjoining nurseries. No trace of their whereabouts have been discovered. They used implements stolen from the kitchen for tunnelling operations, made candles from grease and tallow to light the tunnel and improvised a fan to ventilate and each man had a knapsack of provisions saved from his meals or stolen from the kitchen.
