

TO FACE TRIAL IN JUNE

Germans Accused of Welland Canal Plot Will Be Tried Speedily.

New York, May 22.—That the Government intends a speedy trial of Captain Hans Tauscher and the other Germans and German-Americans implicated in indictments charging conspiracy in the United States to destroy the Welland Canal, was indicated to-day.

Assistant District Attorney Wood notified counsel for Tauscher that he expected the case to go before a jury by the first week in June. Judge Wolverton to-day took under advisement arguments submitted by Attorney Smyth, for Tauscher, on a demurrer plea.

Smyth contended that as the indictment did not contain proof of a "military enterprise" being organized in the United States, the mere carrying of dynamite and pistols not being susceptible of classification of "armament."

The arraignment of Franz Von Igel scheduled for to-day, went over until Wednesday.
