

HIRE CANADIANS ONLY, IS PROPOSAL

Racing Circuits Plan to Employ Natives Instead of Foreigners

MONTREAL, May 22—The "Canada for Canadians" campaign inaugurated this season by Canadian employes on the racing circuits will have the backing of the Canadian labor department.

Montreal tracks are in receipt of a circular letter from the department of labor, in which they are requested to observe the letter and spirit of the alien labor law as closely as possible and give preference to Canadians over employes of other nationalities.

"This is done as much as possible," said one of the local trackmen, "but our object is to get efficient men. Unfortunately there is not a sufficient number of Canadians qualified to take responsible positions at the track, but the number has been increased yearly, and in a few years it will be possible, I think, to fill every position at the track with Canadians."
