150 Austrians passed through the city at noon today enroute to Creighton Mine, near Sudbury. They were formerly interned at Fort William and have been released to work in that mine. They came down on the Alberta and were transferred to the C. P. R. train which was held twenty minutes for them. Chief of Police R. C. Vincent was on hand at the Government dock to see that there were no escapes and reports that everything passed off beautifully.
