

MAJOR W. DATE GOES WEST

Provost Marshal Appointed Commandant of Lethbridge Internment Camp

Major W. E. Date, who has been Provost Marshal here ever since the work of rounding up enemy aliens started, has been appointed commandant of the Internment Camp for enemy aliens near Lethbridge, Alta. Major Date will be relieved from duty at the enemy aliens' prison on St. Antoine street today, his duties being temporarily taken over by Capt. (Dr.) Gurd, the medical officer at the immigration building, and he will leave for the west early next week.

The work with the enemy aliens here has been gradually dropping off for many months past, as the majority of those who needed internment had been rounded up and sent to Spirit Lake or the German camp at Kingston.
