## GERMANS FIGHT STRIKERS, CLAIM

Teamsters Assert Cartage Companies Import Aliens To Defeat Wage Demands

German strikebreakers, imported for the purpose of smashing the teamsters' strike, have recently been arrested on the streets of Winnipeg by the military police, according to statements made Friday night at a meeting of the striking union men held in the Labor temple.

One arrest was made on Rorie street on Friday afternoon. A private detective who is working for the master carters also was taken in custody for trying to prevent the alien's apprehension. Two other German strike-breakers were arrested previ-

It was reported that the Transcona Machinists' union had passed a vote of sympathy, and had made it concrete by sending \$50 toward the teamsters' strike fund.

The teamsters have received word that 18 teamsters have arrived from the west to act as strike-breakers, and 50 more are expected shortly from the Calgary district. These men are carrying contracts for \$3.00 a day and free board and transportation, it is said.
