

# CONTROLLERS GENEROUS

**Make Grants To a Number of Toronto Battalions To-day.**

The Board of Control to-day considered the applications for grants to the different battalions, and encouraged by the action of the York County Council in voting \$5,000 to the 229th Battalion, the controllers were inclined to be generous to some of the battalions.

Controller Cameron surprised his colleagues in opposing a grant to the 70th Battery. He said that complaints had come to him that the boys were not being fed properly and for that reason he would not support the battery.

"That is a good reason why you should support a grant," said Controller Thompson.

"I have heard that the conditions are intolerable at Petawawa," said the Mayor.

In spite of Controller Cameron's opposition the board voted a grant of \$250. Other grants allowed were as follows: Recruiting Depot, \$1,000; University Units, \$500; No. 1 Construction Battalion, \$1,040; 234th Overseas Battalion, \$500; Ammunition Column, 12th Brigade, C. E. F., \$250; Ammunition Column, 13th Brigade, C.E.F., \$250; Royal Canadian Horse Artillery, \$250; Royal Canadian Dragoons, \$300; 201st Battalion, \$1,000.
