## AS ALIEN ENEMIES; FOUGHT FOR BRITAIN Returned Soldiers' Bureau Un Against Peculiar and Very Embarrassing Problem

BULGARIANS BACK

The Returned Soldiers' Bureau faces as peculiar and embarrausing problems in chaving to deal with Bulgarians, who, having equipted in the Canadian fercey-duding the sarly stages of the war, and in some cases fought as have been wounded at the front, are now being returned to Canada as aliencements and undestrables.

When the 191st was recruiting in

Edmonton, shortly aften war was declared, 100 or more Bulgarians signed op with that unit and on their arrival in England a record of the number was taken by the Bulgarian consul, and since the entry of Bulgaria into the war as the ally of Germany, the British authorities have ordered the recall of these men and they are being sent buck to Canada.

Those who have been recalled are coming back gradually, and about six of them have already arrived in Edmonton. As they all wear returned

soldiers' colors and buttons, the bureau is treating them as returned soldiers and not as aliens. There is no other testimony on hand but of these men having acquitted themselves honorably. The difficulty is increased in getting employment for them as they are un-

der the ban as alien enemies.
