

# ESCAPED FROM FT. HENRY

Three Men Got Away From Internment Camp in Boat.

Kingston, July 3.—Three prisoners interned in Fort Henry, have escaped from the internment camp. The three men, who were "trusties," were employed in repairing the engine in a motorboat, which was tied along the shore. After getting the engine into good working order they left for parts unknown. It is thought that they landed near Cape Vincent as the boat was found near there. Before leaving the boat the prisoners put the engine out of commission. Nothing has been heard of the men.
