

Trusties Escaped by Boat.

KINGSTON, Ont., July 5.—Three German "Trusties" escaped from the internment camp at Fort Henry in an officer's gasoline boat which they were allowed to repair. While on a trial spin they overpowered and tied up securely the armed guard who had been supervising their work and then headed the boat for the U. S. shore, where they landed and disappeared. They had smuggled into the boat an extra supply of gasoline. The officer was found bound later by some people who happened to be passing.
