CANADA SETS ALIENS FREE

ada's interned aliens are now being released. Between 1,300 and 2,000 Germans and Austrians have been allowed to leave Spirit Lake, Que., and Kapus-

kasing, Ont., the large camp along the N. T. R. line, where there are now less than a hundred aliens. The reason for the release of the

men is the great improvement in employment conditions in Canada, in factories, and on farms.

Complaints as to the treatment of aliens in Kapuskasing, Spirit Lake, and other such camps, have been re-

ceived. The Government was able to assure the United States consul that

they were unfounded.
