Two Governments Help.

OTTAWA, July 31.—Attempts are being made by the federal authorities to co-operate with the government in coping with the situation created by the conflagration in the northern On-

tario forests. Dominion railway officials have been notified to place all available buildings, box cars, etc., at the temporary disposal of the populace. A train in charge of F. P. Brady and Supt. Hay of the National Transcontinental Railway left Winnipeg last night with provisions, tents and clothing. Application has been made to the militia department to have any available tents placed at the disposal of homeless people while it is probable that part of the accommodation at the internment camp at Kapuskasing and Spirit Lake will be similarly utilized.
