

TWO MORE GERMANS TRIED TO ESCAPE

But Wideawake Guards Pre- vented Them Making Their Getaway.

Two more German prisoners attempted to escape from Fort Henry on Tuesday last, but before they could slip away the guards at the internment camp got wind of their scheme and they were stopped before they could get away. For two months these men have been working for the escape, and only very disappointed now that their attempt has failed.

The last escape has kept all the guards very watchful, and every nook and corner was searched, with the result that a small passage way was found partly burrowed through the ground. An systematic search is periodically made, and these passages were found.
