

Interns Escape from Lethbridge.

For good or bad reason the detention camp at Jasper was broken up some weeks ago and most of the prisoners sent to work for the several railways. Some 22, however, were taken to Lethbridge where they were supposed to be placed under more efficient guardianship or management. On Saturday the 16th one of them with another intern successfully made their escape. The Herald of Lethbridge in reporting the occurrence mentions that the escape was easy because the special guard who was on their particular cells went too. Also that his departure was likely for some time before the escape was made. All of which would seem to indicate that if the purpose was to keep the interns in custody they had better ben left at Jasper. Evidently the patronage system that kept an unfaithful guard in employment at Lethbridge was the cause of the escape.
