

# FIVE AUSTRIANS WERE FINED FOR BREAKING PAROLE

## Heavy Docket Faced Magistrate Elliot at Police Court

There was quite a docket at the police court this morning, there being fifteen on hand charged with violating some law or other. There were seven Austrians in court charged with breaking parole, two drunks, two disorderlies and four sailors charged with obtaining money by false pretences.

J. M. Grash, J. J. Redburn, Jack Cowan, and Harry Silver are said to have signed on as sailors on a ship at Midland, receiving \$2, and then to have signed on with another ship, and a charge was laid of obtaining money by false pretences. The charge was dismissed when the informant wished to withdraw it.

Nicoll Hardin, Steve Kawasaki, Tom Novitaki, John Nawaski, Dick Cijimpus were each fined \$50 and costs or 3 months for breaking parole.

Profera Hyschink was fined \$2 and costs for attempting to go across the river. John Koak had his citizenship papers, so he was allowed to go on a similar charge.
