

MYSTERIOUS ESCAPE OF ENEMY PRISONERS

Fernie, Nov. 18.—Another mysterious escape from the Morrissey internment camp occurred recently when first class prisoners effectually evaded the guard and have not been recaptured. According to the report of the escape the men were within the confines of the camp at 6.20 in the evening, but an ex-guard from the camp positively asserts he recognized the three escaped men on the depot platform here immediately before the eastbound passenger train arrived, less than one hour later. Morrissey camp is ten miles distant, and while a freight train preceded the passenger train to Fernie, it did not make a stop at Morrissey. This was the only known mode of speedy transit, and as the prisoners were positively identified as being here within that time, the manner in which they reached this city is a suspicious mystery.
